This sheet provides only an estimate of what you will pay in rent to the property owner and what CHA will pay to the property owner. You will pay between 30% and 40% of your adjusted gross monthly income for rent and utilities. The actual amounts cannot be confirmed until you find a unit and the property owner agrees with the rent offer. This sheet is for your information purposes only.

Maximum Family Portion	\$ 1,402	<i>This is the most you can afford to pay out of your pocket for rent and utilities.</i>
Maximum Unit Total	\$ 1,742	<i>Total cost of rent and utilities should not exceed this amount.</i>

* If the rent amount (including all utilities paid) is lower than the **Minimum Family Portion** (listed above), you will be paying the entire portion and CHA will not enter into a contract with the property owner.

In order to determine if you can afford the unit, find out what utilities you have to pay. Refer to the *Participant Guidebook* for the amounts CHA will use to calculate the cost of tenant paid utilities (Utility Allowance). Make sure you pay attention to the type of unit (Single-Family, High Rise, etc.) and the number of bedrooms on your voucher.

Add the amount for tenant-paid utilities to the rent amount the property owner requested. The total cannot exceed the amount indicated below:

You can afford up to this amount for rent and utilities: \$ 1,742
